教育資源電子通訊 Educational Resources e-Bulletin

The general public can register and receive the Educational Resources e-Bulletin periodically via e-mail. It includes topics on meteorology, atmospheric phenomena, radiation, earthquake, space weather, astronomy, as well as the latest about training courses and activities for the public.

公眾課程 Public Courses

天文台舉辦氣象基礎課程，以提高公眾的防災意識。課程包括天氣觀測、數值天氣預報、天氣圖解讀及天氣預報、天氣雷達及衛星圖像解讀等。除此之外，天文台亦會到各小學向師生灌輸基礎氣象知識。透過舉辦這些活動，天文台亦可進一步了解市民對服務的需求。有關課程講義已放在網頁上，方便公眾參考閱讀。



The Observatory holds basic weather courses for the public to promote disaster awareness. These courses



include weather observation, numerical weather prediction, weather chart interpretation and weather forecasting, interpretation of radar and satellite images etc. Besides, the Observatory also visits primary schools to inculcate teachers and students with basic meteorological knowledge. Conduct of these activities also enables the Observatory to have a better understanding of public requirements on its services. Notes of the courses are available on the Internet for access by the public.

天文台一向不遺餘力，推動持續進修，不時會為政府各部門員工舉辦氣象及輻射課程。我們會為團體機構開辦天氣入門講座，使他們在進行戶外活動時，能因應天氣情況而隨機應變，以策安全。此外，天文台與極受歡迎的「香港教育城」合作，為師生舉辦活動及提供教材。

The Observatory strongly advocates continuous education courses for civil servants on weather and radiation which are held from time to time. Seminars for organizations and corporations are provided, so that they can take appropriate precautions against severe weather when holding activities outdoor. The Observatory also collaborates with the very popular Hong Kong Education City in organizing activities and providing teaching materials to the teachers and the students.
